Purdue Galleries will be sponsoring an exhibit of Quilt National quilts October 28 through December 6. From Purdue Galleries' website: *"Quilt National is a biennial juried competition dedicated to the promotion of the contemporary art quilt ..."* The quilts are art and can push you out of your comfort zone, but can be appreciated technically even if you would never make one like them. You may have seen past exhibits at the Chicago Quilt Festival, the International Quilt Festival, or the AQS Show in Paducah. This is a very special opportunity to see a nationally recognized group of quilts. Fountain Gallery is at 330 Main in downtown Lafayette. Morning guild members are encouraged to attend the evening meeting or go on your own. Gallery hours are Tuesday through Saturday, Noon -7 p.m.
